**Public Works Committee Meeting- Minutes

MEETING LOCATION-Public Works Facility**

A meeting of the Public Works Committee of the Village of Indian Head Park was held on January 31, 2022 at the IHP Public Works Facility 11308 70<sup>th</sup> Place. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm.

The following were discussed:

- A. Minutes for the December 22, 2021 were approved by unanimous voice vote (Chair Kennedy motion/Mayor Hinshaw second).
- B. Task orders for the road program was deferred pending further investigation. (The go ahead for the Acacia Circle repaving was given.)
- C. Potential water main replacement areas were discussed. Joliet Road and possibly the north segment of Black Hawk Trail.
- D. DuRocher updated the Committee as to the status of the IEPA Loan. The current loan will be paid off in about a year. The engineering for the pump house repair is underway.
- E. Street signs. Examples provided. Estimated total project is \$70,000. This could be a multi-year project.
- F. Discussion of a scissor lift. Cost is under \$10,000 and will be included in next year's budget.

- G. PW is looking to further develop its GIS program and will be working with the Sidwell Company to put some of our maps (*e.g.* tree locations, road repair history) on-line.
  
- H. Community shred/recycling day will be in April (Now scheduled for May 21.)
  
- I. The new truck (to replace the one that was destroyed by fire) is expected to arrive mid-March.
  
- J. Wolf Road Phase 1 study. Will get 1 to 2 alternatives for a public meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:12pm.
